It is part of an impressive ridge that features multiple summits and is popular for its difficulty. As a result, it is logical to think of the trip as a part of the Rolwaling Himal as a whole. You can see the Kongde Ri rising above the Bhote Kosi River to the southwest of Namche Bazar. It locates in the Khumbu region. The mountain's northern flank, which consists of a number of steep ridges that descend toward the north, creates an impressive barrier. The mountain's northern face forms this barrier.

Day 6: Trek to Lumding kharka,o/n in camp (B,L,D)

Day 7: Trek to Kongde Ri Base camp, o/n in camp (B,L,D)

Day 8-9: Trek to High camp, o/n in camp (B,L,D)

Day 10-11: Summit Kwangde Ri (6011 m.) and back to high camp,o/n in camp (B,L
